

Your DSE Checklist



If staff are hybrid workers, two assessments should be carried out - One at work, one at home

Key areas to consider in your DSE Risk Assessments

Work surface Mouse Suitable height Ability to adjust the position to suit the user. Adequate space for flexible arrangement of equipment/documents **Telephone** Glare-free surface. Ability to adjust the position to suit the user Chair Hands-free headset is provided for heavy usage. Stable (five castor base) **Adjustable** Lighting Adequate lighting Leg room Window blinds installed if necessary to minimise glare. Clearance to allow for postural changes. **Noise Footrest** Distracting noise minimised. To be supplied if a user needs one. **Temperature & Environment** Screen Suitable for working in comfort. Stable image **Software** Readable Appropriate to task Adjustable height Adapted to the user if necessary Glare/reflection-free. No undisclosed monitoring.
